

# COVID-19 Guidelines

## For Judiciary Facilities

### 1. **If you are feeling sick, Do Not Enter.**

Judiciary staff should contact a supervisor if they are unable to report when scheduled. Persons seeking court services should contact the court by phone or email without entering the building. COVID-19 symptoms include fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting and diarrhea.

### 2. **Wear a mask.**

By order of the New Jersey Supreme Court, all persons\* entering or occupying a Judiciary facility for Judiciary business must wear a mask or face covering when in community settings or common areas.

### 3. **Maintain six feet of social distancing.**

In addition to wearing a mask, all persons\* in Judiciary facilities for Judiciary business must maintain social distancing to the extent possible.

\*These requirements are subject to exceptions, including for persons entitled to an ADA accommodation. Please contact the court in advance if you need an accommodation.
