WHEREAS, the Township of Bass River is the owner of property known as the Bass River Township Maintenance Garage located at 5576 Route 9, Block 3, Lot 2, New Gretna, New Jersey (the “Property”); and

WHEREAS, Northeast Remsco Construction, Inc. (hereinafter "NRC") is a New Jersey Corporation performing highway construction work on behalf of the New Jersey Turnpike Authority on the Garden State Parkway; and

WHEREAS, NRC occupies the Property pursuant to a lease agreement and lease extension with the Township, which terminates on March 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Township and NRC wish to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding concerning the disposition and ownership of paving millings generated by NRC's work on the Garden State Parkway Project at the Property; and

WHEREAS, the millings are a result of pavement profiling equipment or scarifying equipment grinding asphalt roadway surfaces and conveying the asphalt particles into dump trucks for removal to an area for re-use or disposal by the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township grants NRC and its subcontractors access to the property to deliver and deposit millings generated on the Parkway project; and

WHEREAS, NRC will deposit approximately 1000 cubic yards of millings on the Property at a location to be designated by the appropriate Township official. NRC will do so at no cost to the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township believes that a Resolution allowing the Memorandum of Understanding is in the best interest of the Township;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Bass River that:

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Troopers were called. She wants to make this information available to people in the community and noted that people should look out for each other. Look out for your neighbors. She feels that it is time to get together and form some sort of protection for the community. Deputy Mayor Capriglione stated that for the time being the current designated bus stops need to be adhered to. Shelters for the some designated stops would be sought.

Mr. S. White stated that someone came into his yard on Route 9 and broke some of his yard decorations. This caused him several hundred dollars worth of damage. He said he followed the bus off the Parkway and it was traveling at least 50 mph in a 35 mph zone.

Being no further comments, the motion to close the public portion was made by Commissioner Bourguignon, seconded by Deputy Mayor Capriglione. All in favor and public portion was closed at 7:34 p.m.

Being no further business to come before the Board the motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Bourguignon, seconded by Deputy Mayor Capriglione. All in favor and meeting was adjourned at 7:34 p.m.
