

Burlington County Emergency Mortgage and Utility Assistance



Has your family income been impacted by COVID-19 due to lay-offs, furloughs or reduced work hours? A new program in Burlington County is now available to assist income eligible homeowners.

Burlington County has contracted with CGP&H to administer an **Emergency Mortgage and Utility Assistance Program**.

The total funding cap per family will be a maximum of 6 months of assistance, with no dollar cap! Assistance is available for mortgage assistance, utility assistance, or a combination of the two.

In order to qualify for either program, an applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. Be a Burlington County resident;
2. Rent/Own and reside in the Property;
3. Household income is less than the following:

Applications will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis.
