RECYCLING IS THE LAW!

IT IS ILLEGAL FOR A TRASH COLLECTOR TO PICK UP TRASH MIXED WITH RECYCLING.

BY MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE - ALL RESIDENTS, BUSINESSES AND INSTITUTIONS MUST RECYCLE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Aluminum Cans
- Antifreeze
- Consumer Electronics (computers)
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Fluorescent Lights
- Glass Containers
- Lead Acid Batteries
- Leaves
- Metal Appliances
- Paper
- Plastic Bottles (coded #1 & #2)
- Rechargeable Batteries
- Steel (tin) cans
- Textiles
- Tires
- Used Motor Oil
- Televisions
