RECYCLING IS THE LAW! IT IS ILLEGAL FOR A TRASH COLLECTOR TO PICK UP TRASH MIXED WITH RECYCLING.

BY MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE - ALL RESIDENTS, BUSINESSES AND INSTITUTIONS MUST RECYCLE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Aluminum Cans
- Antifreeze
- Consumer Electronics (computers)
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Fluorescent Lights
- Glass Containers
- Lead Acid Batteries
- Leaves
- Metal Appliances
- Paper
- Plastic Bottles (coded #1 & #2)
- Rechargeable Batteries
- Steel (tin) cans
- Textiles
- Tires
- Used Motor Oil
- Televisions

RECYCLE THESE ITEMS:

PAPER, CARDBOARD and JUNK MAIL TOO!

Includes: junk mail, window envelopes, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, brown grocery bags, gray paperboard (such as cereal & tissue boxes), shredded paper, school and office paper.



SHREDDED PAPER

FIRST PUT SHRED IN PAPER BAG OR CARDBOARD BOX – THEN PLACE IN CART TO RECYCLE. **DO NOT PUT IN PLASTIC BAGS!**



GLASS BOTTLES & JARS • METAL CANS

Including EMPTY non-hazardous aerosols



1 & 2 PLASTIC BOTTLES & JARS



BEVERAGE, SOUP AND SAUCE CARTONS



THEY JAM UP OUR SORTING EQUIPMENT
RECYCLE AT GROCERY STORES

DO NOT RECYCLE:

NO HARDBACK BOOKS, FROZEN FOOD OR FOOD-CONTAMINATED BOXES



NO LOOSE SHREDDED PAPER IT MAKES A MESS!



NO PLASTIC PAILS, TUBS, TRAYS, FOOD CONTAINERS OR FOIL ITEMS

IMPORTANT: **Do not recycle #1 & #2 TUBS AND TRAYS AND ANY #3 THRU #7 PLASTICS.** We must send them to the landfill.



NO BULBS, DISHES, GLASSWARE OR WINDOW GLASS



NO MOTOR OIL, PAINT OR PESTICIDE CONTAINERS



NO PLASTIC WRAP OR STYROFOAM

PAPER

PUT IN PAPER BAGS OR BUNDLE IT

CARDBOARD

MIX WITH PAPER
FLATTEN BOXES
REMOVE STYROFOAM, PLASTIC AND WOOD



Put recycling in **PROPER CONTAINERS** in your recycling dropoff area

BOTTLES, CANS AND BEVERAGE, SOUP & SAUCE CARTONS

PLEASE RINSE
LABELS ARE OKAY
NO CAPS OR LIDS
DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS
