DO NOT RECYCLE:

NO PLASTIC BAGS

They jam up our sorting equipment. Recycle at grocery stores.



NO HARDBACK BOOKS, FROZEN FOOD OR FOOD-CONTAMINATED BOXES



NO PLASTIC PAILS, TUBS, TRAYS, FOOD CONTAINERS OR FOIL ITEMS

IMPORTANT: **DO NOT RECYCLE** #1 & #2 TUBS AND TRAYS AND ANY #3 THRU #7 PLASTICS.

We must send them to the landfill.



NO MUGS, GLASSES, VASES, BULBS, BAKEWARE, DISHES OR WINDOW GLASS



NO PLASTIC, STYROFOAM, LIDS OR CAPS



NO MOTOR OIL, LUBRICANTS, PAINT OR PESTICIDE CONTAINERS



HOW TO RECYCLE:

PAPER

PUT IN PAPER BAGS OR BUNDLE IT

CARDBOARD

MIX WITH PAPER
FLATTEN BOXES
REMOVE STYROFOAM, PLASTIC AND WOOD



Put recycling in **PROPER CONTAINERS** in your recycling dropoff area



BOTTLES, CANS AND BEVERAGE, SOUP & SAUCE CARTONS

NO CAPS OR LIDS
