1.01.010 Adoption.

There is adopted the "Bass River Township Code," as compiled, edited and published by Matthew Bender & Co., Inc.

1.01.020 Title--Citation--Reference.

This code shall be known as the "Bass River Township Code" and it shall be sufficient to refer to said code as "Bass River Township Code" in any prosecution for the violation of any provision of this code or in any proceeding at law or equity. It is sufficient to designate any ordinance adding to, amending, correcting or repealing all or any part or portion of this code as an addition to, amendment to, correction or repeal of the "Bass River Township Code." References may be made to the titles, chapters, sections and subsection of the "Bass River Township Code" and such references shall apply to those title, chapters, sections or subsections as they appear in the code.

1.01.030 Reference applies to all amendments.

Whenever a reference is made to this code as "Bass River Township Code" or to any portion thereof, or to any ordinance of the township of Bass River, codified herein, the reference shall apply to all amendments, corrections and additions heretofore, now or hereafter made.

1.01.040 Title, chapter and section headings.

Title, chapter and section headings contained in this code shall not be deemed to govern, limit, modify or in any manner affect the scope, meaning or intent of the provisions of any title, chapter or section in this code.

1.01.050 Reference to specific ordinances.

The provisions of this code shall not in any manner affect matters of record which refer to, or are otherwise connected with ordinances which are therein specifically designated by number or otherwise and which are included within the code, but such reference shall be construed to apply to the corresponding provisions contained within this code.

1.01.060 Ordinances passed prior to adoption of the code.

The last ordinance included in this code was Ordinance 2001-2 passed February 26, 2001. The following ordinances, passed subsequent to Ordinance 2001-2, but prior to adoption of this code, are adopted and made a part of this code: Ordinances 2001-01, 2001-03, 2001-04, 2001-05, 2001-06, 2001-07, 2001-08, 2001-09; 2002-01, 2002-02, 2002-03, 2002-04, 2002-05, 2002-06.

GENERAL PENALTY

1.08.010 Adopted.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-5, as amended, the ordinance codified in this chapter is adopted by the township, to be known as Penalties for the Violation of Ordinances of the Township of Bass River, setting forth the minimum and maximum penalties which shall be imposed upon violation of any ordinance in the township, where there is no specific penalty provided regarding this particular section or sections violated.

1.08.020 Maximum penalties for ordinance violations.

A. For a violation of any provisions of any ordinance of the township where no specific penalties are provided regarding the section or sections violated, the maximum penalty, upon conviction, shall be one or more of the following:

1. Imprisonment in the county jail or in any place provided by the municipality for the detention of prisoners, for any term not exceeding ninety (90) days; or
2. By a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00); or
3. By a period of community service not exceeding ninety (90) days.

B. Any person convicted of the violation of any ordinance in the township may, in the discretion of the court by which he or she is convicted, and in default of the payment of any fine imposed therefore, be imprisoned in the county jail or place of detention provided by the municipality, for any term not exceeding ninety (90) days, or be required to perform community service for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days.

C. Enforcement in a municipal court by way of prosecution for violations of any ordinance shall not be exclusive and shall not preclude other remedies that may be available at law.

1.08.030 Separate violations.

Except as otherwise provided, each and every day in which a violation of any ordinance of the township exists shall constitute a separate violation, and the person or persons allowing or permitting the continuation of the violation may be punished as provided as provided above for each separate offense.

1.08.040 Penalty for ordinance violations.

The one hundred dollar (\$100.00) minimum penalty set forth in this section is applicable only to ordinances which do not specify a minimum penalty.

The two thousand dollar (\$2,000.00) maximum penalty set forth in this section is applicable only to ordinances which do not specify a maximum penalty.
